

# How to Install a Satellite Dish - A Step by Step Guide

You may be asking yourself how to [install](#) a satellite dish in your yard. If you have never had this question asked to you before, you are about to be hit with some pretty expensive bills. That's because you are now required by law to get satellite dishes for your home. Sure, you can pay someone else to do it, but why pay thousands of dollars more than you have to? It just makes sense.

Fortunately, there is no "How to install a satellite dish" online video tutorial that I can find. Most satellite dish sites have step-by-step tutorials and installation videos for their dishes, but they are very expensive! Luckily, if you want to learn how to install a satellite dish for free (which is a big plus) then here are some things that you need to know.

One: Before you get started, you will need to make sure that you have all of the proper hardware necessary. There are certain types of satellite dishes and each one requires special things to support it properly. Without the correct equipment you will not be able to receive your service. Luckily, most satellite companies will either offer manuals or toll-free numbers to help you with this.

Two: Next you will need to decide where you would like to install the satellite dish. There are typically two options; mounts that are placed on the outside of your house and ones that are put into the ground. Usually, you will have to get an installer to go with you so that he or she can carefully get these things into place for you.

Three: Once you know where you want to mount it, the next step in the process of how to install a satellite dish is deciding what type of satellite dish you will need. There are many different types to choose from including Fixed and Shade Technology. Both offer different advantages, but some prefer one over the other. Once again, an installer will come into play here as well.

Four: After making the decision of what type of satellite dish you will need, it is time to decide what receiver you will be using. This is extremely important because it will determine the quality of service you receive. There are three common types; UHF/VHF, Short/Wide and

UHF/Matched. It is best to get the correct one. Once again, an installer will come into play here as he or she will be able to figure out which one is the right one for you.

Five: Finally, the last step in the process of how to install a satellite dish is placing your satellite in the proper location. The primary factors to consider here include where your dish will need to face, the elevation and direction of the location and the signal. If you have already picked a mount, most will simply ask you if you want a tilt-type or tension mount. Tilt mounts are preferred since they enable you to move the satellite at a specific angle. Meanwhile, tension mounts are better for areas that need some stability.

How to install a satellite dish is a process that doesn't have a definitive set of steps. However, once you have completed the basic steps outlined above, you will be ready to enjoy your television experience. Just remember to get all of your paperwork together before you start working on your dish, including any and all necessary permits. You will also need to get a clear view of the southern sky in order to receive a strong signal from orbiting satellites.
